If it's mostly brownies they are going to be real sluggish if the temperatures are below 50°, and I'm betting if there's snow on the ground the water temperature is under 40°.

Brookies are more active in cold weather, though when the temps are below 40° brookies are sluggish too. What you found is pretty typical for early spring. Plus there have been quite a few cold fronts coming through so that's slowing fishing down too.
