I fish a little but ridiculously heavy anchor pattern I call my K.I.S.S. Pupa. I was thinking about making a post about it and now I think I am. It uses four materials and is very quick and easy to tie. I usually tie them on size 14-12. I use a tungsten bead, as large as I can get away with. I then coat the entire shank in .015 lead, and make about five wraps of .020 over the .015 up near the bead. The best part is I actually catch half of my fish on it. It is usually a dead split as far as effectiveness between the Pupa anchor and whatever I am using as a dropper. Although, sometimes the dropper does catch more, the Pupa is still VERY effective, you should try it. Let me know if you want the recipe and instructions...
