"It's often at least mid-April before you hit 50 in the pm. And we're behind this year. ... Heck, at the jam last year, late May, highs around 80 and lows in the 50's. Morning water temps were in the 40's, afternoon temps mid 50's. "

TWC says lo54/hi66 for wilkes-barre monday. Accuweather says 50-63 mon and 52-71 tues. Fish for brookies late PM in the poconos, and the water temps should be good enough.

I have been brookie fishing a lot lately, had good dry fly fishing on days when the air temps ranged from 38-54, water low-mid 40s. Things should only be better in a few days with 50-60s air temp range. Not sure the water temps at last year's jam say much about it?

Water temps arent everything. There are streams where brookies hit dries reasonably well in water below 40....
