Not really Pat, I was out Thursday and the stream I was fishing was 40 degrees when we arrived, by the time we left it was 48 degrees. Then yesterday at the same stream in a different section but nearby it was up to 54 degrees. Thursday overnight temperatures weren't as cold as the night before.

I was on Big Pine one May and in the Morning it was 46 degrees, when I left it was 63 degrees. It's about bright sun and no leaves that raises water temperatures rapidly. This time of the year streams warm very fast. and if the nights are warmer, then they don't cool down as fast overnight.
