Good suggestions my McSneek. Muddy is very clear right now. It is best after a rain and won't see new fish til next week. Its pretty slow there with lots of pressure. Things should heat up in later april when the inseason stockings start, pressure dies and truck chasers dictate the crowds.

PS, Caddis dries, caddis pupae, larvae, wet flies in caddis and oh yeah....caddis. Still some stoneflies around and I saw a hendrickson today too on the SB. Phesant tails with and w/o beads always work too slow drifted through riffles and pools.

Stay dopwnstream of the spot you are fishing when its clear. Lots of fish in the fly area too so don't over look that area.
