if I am nymphing I use a tippet ring and tie two pieces of tippet to the ring.....this would be akin to leaving a long tag end on a blood knot or surgeons knot. I find it allows me to change the top fly much more often.

If I am going dry dropper then it is always inline....I have tried tying off the eye but I find that line will fowl my hackle/deer hair/cdc or whatever I have for the wing of my dry and cause it to float ugly....this might actually look better to trout but I can't stand it....so long story short I use improved clinch knot off the bend but I pinch the start of the knot and hook of the dry between my fore finger and thumb and tie the rest with my other hand.
