I got into a pod of rising fish on the Tully. I didn't know exactly what they were on but it appeared to be some type of emergers. Having read this thread earlier I decided to try two soft hackles. Well, it really worked! Fished for about an hour. Brought 7 to hand, employed the long distance release on 4 and missed many others. The top producer was a flashback pheasant tail soft hackle which is a traditionally tied PT with partridge hackle. I tie a piece of pearl or green flashabou over the back underneath the gold rib. Most of the takes were on a fairly tight line as the wet flies swung right through the zone of the feeding fish. It was a very effective technique and a lot of fun!
