Forget the Jordan as it is very low and clear and the park you are referring to is not very pleasant. Go to the Little Lehigh or the Saucon or Monacacy. Those 3 are far better choices.

The Covered Bridge Park on Wehr's Mill Road is a nicer park than on any of the Valley limestoners - it's in a fairly upscale neighborhood.

The Jordan in Covered Bridge Park is a stocked fish only stream - it gets way too warm to support trout year 'round. IMO, Jordan Creek in this area is a model of a stream that should be stocked - it provides a great place for early season trout fishing for thousands of anglers.

SBecker is the guy to talk to about fishing there. Around here, he's known as the "King of Jordan".
