There is SOOO much skinny, flat and slate bottomed, featureless water on Little Sandy... such a shame. you can see where years ago, stream structures were placed but now are eroded-behind. And this lack of structure in a mature woods. I don't know what could be done without a backhoe to do some serious ground breaking in the stream. A jack-dam won't make structure in solid rock. Also, the pump-house pool has that separate channel draining maybe as much as 1/2 the water from the stream. And the best stream work habitat is below this.

Little Sandy, from below the pumphouse to the tressel will be a tough fix!
