does the yellow breeches get to warm in the summer or is it a good temp all year. My other question is do you think that the brook was wild or do they stock the stream. thanks

YB does indeed get warm and temps over 75 degrees are common in summer. There are some springs and thermal refuges that allow for trout survival. The spring that forms "The Run" is the largest and stays cold year round.

The stream is heavily stocked and the brookie you caught was a stocked fish. There are some wild browns (I got a very fat six incher yesterday at Allenberry) but generally YB is a stocked fishery.
