Downstream fishing is best utilized when either swinging wet flies or streamers, or when fishing dries to super expert wild fish in limestone streams where vegetation has caused the currents to "braid", thus making the ideal up-and-across presentation all but impossible. Even direct upstream casts are usually plagued by drag in braided currents. At those times, a downstream cast with a load of slack tippet is often your best bet.
