I have caught a ton of WW on drys yet have never caught a trout on a dry .. all mine are on nymphs and buggers. I'm not experienced enough to "match a hatch" but do my best to fish with the closest looking dry in my box when fish are rising to something as well as fished with terrestrials during the season. Drift is fairly accurate and I mend often when there is drag. My guess is presentation and how does one get better at that? I feel like I can practice casting in my yard but when I'm on the H2O it is pot luck if the fly is right side up, proper direction, etc, etc ...

Is it just a matter of re-casting if you fail on the original presentation?
