Yea nymphing is frustrating. I can't speak from experience, but George Daniels in his dynamic nymphing book says he likes to put his sighter right before the tippet. The he greases it and makes he tippet long enough to get his fly where it needs to be. Because he puts it after the midsection, he uses like 8 or 10 lb test. Usually not amnesia. I think he uses gold stren.

He's also an advocate of indicator nymphing using either a dry and dropper or a thingamabobber.

It's a really good book, and the electronic version was free on amazon for a while. If it's still free and you have a device that can read kindle ebooks, it may be worth getting.
