It's hard to say with just the info you've given.

How are you fishing? Are you trying a tight line technique or just dead drifting with the entire leader on the water?

If the former, consider using the stren (or similiar) in the midsection of the leader and work on your technique.

If the later, consider using an adjustable floating indicator like a thingamabobber, yarn puff, or foam & peg style. I've never been a fan of relying on a amnesia butt for dead drift strike indication. If you have 9' of leader and tippet and are fishing only a couple feet of water, there is often enough slack in the leader that a strike does not register as movement in the butt quick enough. At the very least the fish has to hold the fly longer before you notice a strike. Adjustable indicators allow you to balance between distance to fly and strike detection.

There are numerous other possible reasons you aren't catching fish too.
