There are many places to fish around Huntingdon. A couple good ones to check out would be Standing Stone Creek or Little Juniata River (this would be upriver from Huntingdon above Petersburg). You can also fish the Juniata River right in and around town for bass and panfish. If you check the upper right corner of this page, hit the link for Pennsylvania Trout Streams and there is a lot of info there.

There is a short but nice public stretch of Spruce Creek, about a half mile, where you can fish that is upstream from the town of the same name (look for the brown sign that says Penn State). Otherwise, Spruce is pretty much all posted.
