On average the hole seems to be bigger, pretty much combining two holes, and deeper throughout. Still was deep because of the plunge pool, but the entire pool wasn't deep. Now it is and mainly slower moving but still a good flow. Has some good underwater structure which could possibly have a bruiser or two living under it. Overall I guess the "quality" of the hole is still the same, just different. Maybe even better? I guess I'll find out next time.
