Looked like an S shape wriggling the entire few seconds I saw it. It then came up into a riffle and shortened, fattened and was now a crane fly larvae. So while a walts worm looks like a crane fly larvae when tied large, really when they drift through the column, they swim. and are flat and curves like an S.
