This is my first post here on PAFF, and I caught my first two trout ever on a flyrod, at Neshannock today. Landed two decent sized brown trout under the bridge behind the shop, around 2PM today. I was using a size 14 copper john with green crystal bead. I ended up losing 2 of these flies and didn't have any more, so tried a few other patterns but no luck after this except for a chub. Walked maybe a mile down the stream and tried to target some areas that looked promising, but no success.

Seeing some of the casting that others were doing today made me realize how far I have to go. My learning to this point has been watching YouTube videos of basic techniques and knot-tying, and it just looks so much easier when watching not only pros, but some of the guys on the water today. Just need to suck it up and not let it stress me out. I was probably tangled more than I had a decent cast in the water, but catching those 2 made it worth it.
