If the wind is steady, change your angle and use the wind as your friend. I'm with Chaz, it's been quite windy this year. I fished for 30 minutes in Feb during the newbie jam and I'm itching to get out there but not looking forward to the wind.

Caught several days last year in the Catskills where the wind was 20-25 steady and then it would switch 180 degrees and gust at 45+. I had a nymph rig in the back of my neck, a green drake stuck in my cheek and a prince nymph sooooo deep in the bridge of the nose it took forceps to remove it. As I rowed past DaveS, he looked over to see blood gushing off my nose and all over my gear. When you're in the middle of a 50-60' cast and the wind does complete change of direction, you better duck or open wide.
