I few things. I saw the comment on side pressure. Spot on, except that I didn't see it mentioned to pull away from the fish at all times. Try to get the fish upstream of you. It makes a difference. Don't stand there with your feet planted in one spot. Be ready to move up or downstream as needed. Use your rod to fight the fish, not the line and tippet. There is plenty of stuff to be found on the internet if you do a search, but bottom line is to not have a real steep angle between the fish and your rod. You want the tip of the rod protecting the tippet and the butt of the rod fighting the fish.
