FWIW, the ones which I think are reasonably in the location you found this guy:

Knobbed Salmonfly - biloba

Spiny Salmonfly - comstocki

American Salmonfly - dorsata

Midwestern Salmonfly - pictetii

Appalachian Salmonfly - proteus

From there, troutnut isn't much help, no pictures of winged adults. And overall, it looks like there's an awful lot of misidentification of this order of stoneflies on the net.

FWIW, based on emergence dates, and apparant commonality, it's perhaps more likely dorsata than pictetii? Also, the pictetti pic you have seems to have a much longer orange collar. That said, many of the dorsati pics are brown, but some are blacker.
