"That's what I'm saying. I've been fly fishing for 20 years and know the difference between a crane fly and a sulphur. Fish were on a #14 sulphur dun that began coming off around dinner time. As I said they had been trickling off for days but this was the first time I saw fish keying in on them."

It's also possible you saw *Epeorus Vitreus*, cousin to the Quill Gordon. They hatch earlier in May than the *Dorothea*, usually around dinnertime on Penns Creek. Not sure if they're on Spring Creek. Capture one and see if it has two tails.
