Yes, I'm about as sure as you can get on a fish of this size.

It was 3 miles up a small, unstocked freestoner that has a history of producing some large native brookies (and the occasional large wild brown). I disagree with the pectoral fin, it looks pretty clean on close inspection. The camera doesn't do it justice, but what you are seeing I think are color variations and reflection rather than a ragged edge. With the picture, the best fin shot is of the anal fin, which is clean. Also, sharp distinction between black and white on the fins, which is often a good indicator of wild.
