mine is 100% wild...caught it first in november last year and it had clearly just spawned, then caught it again in mid march. It only survived the winter because it got washed out of a tributary and into a rich limestone environment. Only brookie I've ever caught in the stream, but have caught dozens up to 11.5" from the tributary I believe it came from, which is an unstocked freestone trib to an unstocked limestone trib to an unstocked Class A limestone stream.

WT2's is very obviously a native imo, Pat's I would have said stocked if anyone other than him claimed it was a native.

Just because it's a big trout doesn't make it stocked, my granddad does the same thing- I'll show him pictures of nice wild browns and he'll say "why did someone put that in such a small stream?"
