I would second the Davidson River as a great destination from Asheville. Absolutely beautiful. I have a son who plays college basketball in the Southern Conference, and our post season tournament is held in Asheville in early March.

Another good destination about an hour and 15 minutes away (east on rte 40) is Wilson Creek, north of Morganton. There are tons of fish in it, and you should try the section above the gorge area, (which is usually loaded with white water rafters. ). the upper areas have miles of varied water and tons of willing fish.

There are several excellent fly shops in Asheville as well, which would be a good reference, not to mention many excellent craft breweries and good restaurants in town !
