FrequentTyer's list covers most of it. For woolly buggers and similar trout streamers a 3xl hook will get the job done. I tie most of my buggers in #8 and #10. Definitely buy some scud type hooks like a tmc 2487. Lighter wire models are great for emergers and the heavier ones will suffice for many types of nymphs. Just because, for instance a pheasant tail recipe calls for a 2xl nymph hook doesn't mean you can't tie one on a scud hook.
