The newer burgundy models are higher modulus and are said to be much faster, and likely lighter in the hand. Haven't cast one. If you get it report back. Not sure it makes much difference, but when the newer burgundy model first came out, it was made in Mexico. Now I think they make them in WI and the less expensive blue blank model, whatever they call it now, is made south of the border.
