When I was living down there off and on a number of years ago (I was doing software implementation training for our satellite plant in Charlotte and went back and forth between PA and NC a lot), I spent most of my fishing time either in the upper Wilson Creek watershed in the Pisgah NF fishing the upper end of Wilson itself, N. and S. Harper Creeks and Lost Cove Creek and its tribs. These are all hike-ins varying from 3/4 of a mile to 3 miles. The fishing over mixed BT and RT was pretty good. The other place i liked and spent a fair amount of time on was the South Toe River up in the special regs section. Mostly RT at that time with some pretty good sized ones, up to 12" anyway. This was bigger water and in terms of access, more like the Davidson with sections where you could fall out of your car door and be fishing.

I think both these places are on the outer edge of your hour away from Asheville stipulation. You could look them up and see where where they are and how far of a trip it would be.

I didn't care much for the Davidson. Pretty busy, IMO.
