I don't know of any permanent treatment to seal a fly line but you can apply a line dressing. That should keep it floating for awhile before you need to reapply. I use this [http://buy.scientificanglers.com/acce ...

As for nicks and cuts on your line I'm sure superglue or epoxy would work. I learned a trick from Bruno and Albatross recently. They used Loon UV Wader Repair on a fly line. The stuff cures pretty fast in sunlight.

I didn't realize it but when we were fishing Spring I had a bottle of line dressing in my pack. We could've run your line thru a cloth and dressed it real quick. Sorry about that.
