The what? Lol.

At most, removing 2' is going to only change the weight of line being cast at a fixed distance by a few grains and is negligible. Additionally, the longer a length of line you cast, the less you will notice the difference, if you noticed anything to begin with. You may get a slight difference in leader turnover since you are cutting off a couple feet of what is generally a level tip segment of the fly line. But again, I don't think you'll be changing a whole lot by removing 2 or even 3 feet of line.
