I have a box of streamers, a box for midges, a box for soft hackles and other wets, and then I have what I call my "operational" box which is filled with the flies I use 90% of the time. Caddis, wulffs, Adams, and then a small assortment of other dries, depending on what hatches I can expect to see (right now I have sulphur, cahills, and some MB thrown in)-those take up the right panel. The left panel is filled w/ various nymphs like PT, HE, caddis puppa, etc.

My bass flies are mixed in w/ my streamer box, and my terrestrials are mixed in w/ my wets. Meh. Works for me. I at least know where to find stuff. I really don't have a LOT of flies, compared to some of you guys!
