Spinner is the adult mayfly that returns to the water sometime after it hatched to deposit eggs. usually a spinner fall will take place close to dark.

I was fishing a warm water stream yesterday from roughly noon to 3:00pm. With the cloud cover and sporadic rain there were mayflies coming off occasionally the entire time I was there.

I'm guessing conditions were similar where you were and they were probably a sulphur or cahill. You just may not have had a pattern the fish liked. Perhaps your cahill was too big or the fish might have preferred a low riding comparadun or emerger pattern.

If you're seeing a light colored mayfly come off, you simply need to be prepared with light colored patterns in the right size. Or maybe try to pound them into submission with a parachute Adams.
