I spent some time on Clarks Creek today. The ridge to the North of Clarks Creek is thick with Cicadas. I couldn't find a stretch of stream that had decent activity (checked 3 different stretches of water). I saw one or two flying about while I fished, but the heavy activity was on the ridges on either side of the stream. I didn't bother fishing a cicada pattern and did fine using a caddis.

I headed over to the Stony Creek area on my way home. Nothing doing there. In one spot I could hear cicadas, but they were well off in the distance and not on the streamside of the road.

I'm guessing they've emerged wherever they are going to emerge in PA, and am not optimistic about fishing them.
