Fished the pine creek area around cedar and slate run from 5/31-6/2. Friday I fished some small brook trout streams. The water temps were around 54 on these small streams. Caught a couple nice brookies on attractor dries and had lots of hits from fingerlings too small to take the fly.

Saturday I biked the rail trail along pine creek and fished cedar run in the evening. A good hatch of slate drakes, yellow sallies, a few green drakes/coffin flies, and a mix of other bugs came off during the last hour of daylight. Brought 2 small browns and 1 brookie to hand and missed a few all on dries. The water temp on cedar was 58. I had a lot of small fingerling fish hit the fly here too. I fish cedar run once a year and over the last few yrs I had only caught bigger older fish, so even though that was great it was a relief to see the new generation beginning to grow. I'm sure the big boys are still there somewhere, but they were a no show on this trip.

Sunday morn I fished the lower delayed harvest section of pine creek around slate run for 2 hours around sunrise with my dad. Water temp was 67 and I landed 2 nice stocked browns around 15-16in on nymphs, subsequently discovered I left my camera at the cabin, and broke 1 fish clean off on the take
