If you mean the Pine Creek in Tioga/Lycoming county, the vast majority of the creek will typically be too warm for trout in July. Some fish may still be holding on at the mouths of tribs.

You could target warm/cool water species like smallmouth bass, walleye, rock bass and other sunfish with your spinning rod.

On the other hand this maybe a cool enough year to keep trout into July. But I would not bet on it, I saw temps of 68 above Waterous and 66 above Galeton on 6/1 (a hot day).
