"5. When is a Trout/Salmon Permit required?

A current Pennsylvania trout/salmon permit is required to fish for trout or salmon in Pennsylvania waters. An angler "fishes for trout or salmon" when he or she:

Takes, kills, or possesses, while in the act of fishing, a trout or salmon from any PA or boundary waters.

Fishes in waters under special trout-salmon regulations....[view trout special regulation areas](#).

Fishes in any Class A Wild Trout Waters or Wilderness Trout Streams or their tributaries....[view Class A wild trout waters](#), or [view Wilderness Trout streams](#).

Fishes in streams and rivers designated as approved trout waters on March 1 through May 31....[view approved trout waters](#)."
