Playing off the big guy's Decker post (TimM), I've stayed in Deckers right on some primo S Platte water

The rates have gone up since I was there (hasn't everything?) and it looks like they've made the place nicer - it was pretty basic when I stayed there, but with the windows open, the sounds of the river put me to sleep nicely.

In summer, if you put yourself in South Denver at 5:00, you can be ffishing the SPlatte within an hour.

If you are there several days early, 2 hours can put you up the mountain to Dillon etc. and there are the Blue, interesting brookie ponds right on the Interstate and other waters. Or you could go north to Fort Collins and do the Poudre, but I think the stream has had some setbacks due to fires.

But if you have several days to play with, drive the 4 hrs to Basalt/Aspen and do the Pan, Roaring Fork, etc. May even get into Western Green Drakes (MUCH better ffishing that our Easter GD) and Flavinea, caddis, olives.
