The only thing that I can add is that I've had luck fishing wooly buggers downstream on Kistler especially when the flow is a little higher as it is now. With fishing a WB downstream, you really don't have to cast much. You simply let the WB float down with the current, angle your rod to a prime position, and strip the WB back. Brookies love it.
