Most of my fish catching is the result of homework...studying maps and finding access to remote unpressured streams, analyzing weather and radar data and how it relates to flows, locating hatches...finding the best possible stream conditions given the circumstances. That's how I catch my fish. Certainly not by being the stealthiest, having the most accurate cast, or getting the best drifts. I catch the easy fish...I've just become relatively skilled at finding them given a certain set of conditions.
