Caught many redeyes and big sunnies right off. Smallmouth action startin pickin up. Then I found a good spot and hit jackpot. Caught lots of smallies around 10" and a couple between 12-14". Once the action started picking up the anticipation of a bass striking on about every two or three casts was just the fix I needed for the day.

Caught every fish on a single chartreuse popper. Best day I've had in a long time. I had an absolute blast catching good hard fighting bass today on a five weight fly rod, and for that I am grateful.
