Renzetti here too.

He's seen the light!

Somewhere in the neighborhood of 40,000 flies have been tied on my Renzetti Traveler, and the jaws look like new. Replaced one "o" ring for 19 cents at the Home Depot. My Traveler was the very first cam model sold in the Lehigh Valley.

You can get the Traveler 2000 again for like \$160. It isn't as fancy looking as the anodized version, but it polishes up nicely with some metal polish.

Far better vise than either the Anvil or Peak, IMO. I've tied size 2 to size 32 flies on it, and NEVER had a hook slip.
