I use an app that shows CFS. I believe it's called "RiverFlows". Right now it's showing 318 for the Conestoga which is a bit high to be wading. Get down there in the summer months when it's around 100 and you'll have a good idea what wading is like at that level. The gage height is obviously one measurement, but the CFS is really the best barometer for a stream's wadeability. You'll have fun down there in the summer when the flow drops between 100 and 150.

I love that app. For the Conestoga, there is a Advanced Hydrologic Prediction Service (AHPS) gauge that actually projects flows based on the weather forecast.
