I don't have any experience with Slate Drakes or Yellow Drakes on Laurel Hill. Slate Drakes are usually an all day sporadic kind of hatch. I would think that most of Laurel Hills Slate Drakes crawl up on rocks to change into duns. Swinging big dark wetfls near the rocks may be effective. The Yellow Drakes should be a more concentrated emergence just before dark.
