There are many spring creeks in the area that stay well cold enough to fish through the heat. Some are fished often and are well known (letort, big spring, falling spring, green spring, etc.). There are also quite a few others that are fished heavily early season or in stocked sections and ignored the rest of the time. I'd recommend a copy of [Armstrong's book](#) - you can probably get it through the library as well. This is a great guide to the local limestone streams, though there are still a few that even he missed - Those are my personal favorites!
