I've long suspected that our sewage treatment plant here in Gettysburg is likely part of the problem. This plant has some upgrades coming soon and hopefully that will help the upper Monocacy. The lower sections are excellent and, last time I checked, were part of an experiment with C&R regs for smallies. I release all bass so don't know if these regs are still in place. Maryland DNR surveys have revealed good populations of bass in several year classes in the lower reaches.
