Looking at the 7'9" 4 weight St. Croix Avid for small stream nymphing and small streamers/buggers. For what it's worth I rarely throw dries, so delicate presentations are not terribly important to me, though it will be my brook trout rod on the rare occasion I get to go for them. Wanted to get suggestions on any other rods I should be looking at before I pull the trigger. I love my Grey's 10' 3 weight for euro nymphing but it is often times too much on smaller waters. On big water using indicators I usually fish a 10'6" 5 weight or the old reliable 9' 4 weight. Maybe I just have the itch for a new rod and looking for help in justifying the purchase.
