I'd love to see an electroshocking survey done to see exactly what's in there. I'd be surprised if there are many "trophy trout" in that stream, although I do believe there are probably some 14-18" fish that know how to hide well. Generally speaking, if you're catching wild browns in the 6-10" range, you're catching what most of us are.
