Yeah, for bigger streams, stick to evenings, and especially mornings. Fishing is better, and it's more comfortable. In the heat of the day, head for the hills. Shaded mountain streams, cool water. It's often more comfortable than sitting at home! When you get hot, well, there's cold water to cool you right down. Filling your hat with cold water and sticking it on your head does wonders!!!
