The entire lower east is too warm to fish. The upper east is probably getting close to being too warm before it even gets to the Beaverkill. The west is freezing most of the summer. By the time mid-September rolls around, water temps should be good just about everywhere.

Do slate drakes hatch? Yes. How heavy? That question can be answered as you come off the river. You might see a bunch and the guy that's a mile away doesn't see any. There's enough bugs hatching in early fall to bring the fish up without being overwhelmed by huge numbers of bugs on the water.
