The last was the best ffishing I've had there in almost 40 years of doing the stretch from Slide Inn down to West Fork, both in numbers and size. I also caught up with JayL who's now in Bozeman along with Matt from Walnutport. They live on the Gallatin pretty near Storm Castle. Friday I got a trout grand slam on the G around Mile 49. PPL has been pumping up the volume at Hebgen every day, but when flows at Kirby were 1000 or so, the dry fly fishing was fabulous.

I never got to meet JayL in person, but I do remember him posting frequently when I first started reading the board.

I almost got my first grand slam on Monday, but couldn't find a Brookie. Still haven't caught one since I've gotten out here. I have to get further upstream and into some mountains I guess. I've been fishing 3-4 days a week every week, so stories and pictures to come soon. Also have a fishing trip into Yellowstone in the works as well as another float trip when a guy I met buys his new boat.
